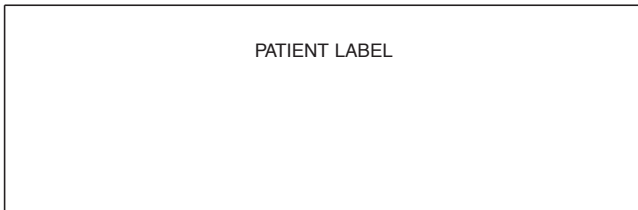

Sky Ridge Medical Center

Directions: Sky Ridge Medical Center is located south of metro Denver at 10101 RidgeGate Parkway in Lone Tree. The medical center is easy to access from Interstate 25 and the Lincoln Avenue exit. After exiting, go west on Lincoln one block to Park Meadows Boulevard. Turn left (south) on Park Meadows Boulevard and the hospital is a quarter mile ahead on the left. The **Radiology Department** is located on the first floor of the main hospital.

Parking: In addition to free parking throughout the campus, complimentary valet parking is available to patients and visitors at the main entrance of the hospital as well as the front entrances of the Aspen and Conifer medical office buildings.

The Sky Ridge Imaging Center at Castle Rock

Directions: When traveling South on I-25, take the Plum Creek Parkway exit. Turn left on Plum Creek Parkway, then right on S. Perry. The Imaging Center is .04 miles on the west side of Perry St.

The Sky Ridge Imaging Center at Lincoln Medical Center

Directions: Turn east on Lincoln at I-25. Travel east on Lincoln, turn south on Oswego, then east at Lioness Way.

Preparation for Common Examinations

Upper G.I. (stomach)

- 1) Nothing by mouth after midnight, including medications. Bring any medication with you to take following the exams.
- 2) Please do not smoke, chew gum or tobacco after midnight.

Barium Enema (colon)

Please obtain Fleets Prep Kit from Sky Ridge Radiology waiting room M-F 7:30 a.m. - 6 p.m.; follow and use 24 hour instructions in prep kit.

Small Bowel

- 1) Nothing by mouth after midnight, including medications. Bring any medication with you to take following the exams.
- 2) Please do not smoke, or chew gum or tobacco the morning of your examination.

Esophogram

No preparation necessary if exam is the only one scheduled. If exam is scheduled with another exam which requires a prep, follow the preparation required for that exam.

I.V.P. Kidney Study (Allow 2 hours)

DAY BEFORE EXAM:

- 1) Adults: Obtain Fleets Prep Kit from Sky Ridge Radiology waiting room M-F 7:30 a.m. - 6 p.m.; follow and use 24 hour instructions in prep kit.
- 2) Nothing by mouth after midnight.

Children Prep for UGI, SBS or Barium Enema

DAY OF EXAM:

- 0 – 6 months: If on formula, nothing by mouth 4 hour prior to exam; If on breast milk, nothing by mouth 3 hours prior to exam.
6 months – 3 years: Nothing by mouth for 4-6 hours prior to exam.
4 years and older: Nothing by mouth 6 hours prior to exam.

CT

CT WITH CONTRAST: Only clear liquids 4 hours prior to the exam, no solid food. Also no Glucophage or Glucovance for 48 hours after the exam. If patient has allergic reaction to contrast in the past, please ask Primary Care Physician for pre-medication instructions; 1 day prep required by Sky Ridge Radiology. Patient must not have had barium study within 48 hours prior to CT Scan. Additional contrast studies (i.e. BE, UGI) must be scheduled after CT. Call our CT Technologist at 720-225-1720 with questions regarding prep.

Nuclear Medicine

STRESS CARDIOLITE: Wear comfortable clothing and walking shoes. No food or drink after midnight the night before. Hold blood pressure/heart medicine until after test and no caffeine for 24 hours prior to exam.

GASTRIC EMPTYING STUDY: No food or drink after midnight the night before the study. Stomach medications should be stopped 24 hours before the exam and all pain medications to be stopped 6 hours before the exam. If your physician wants you to stay on these medications, you must have a written order from him/her, or the exam will need to be rescheduled. If you have questions about a medication you are taking, call 720-225-1790.

THYROID: No CT/X-ray IV contrast for 4 weeks prior to procedure. Discontinue thyroid or anti-thyroid medications for 7-10 days prior to study. Nothing by mouth after midnight.

BONE SCAN: No preparation needed.

HIDA: Eat fatty meal 4 hours prior to study. No pain medications for 6 hours prior to exam.

MRI Scan

All electronic implants and cerebral aneurysm clips within the patient must be evaluated by MRI department for compatibility and patient's safety. Call MRI Technologist at 720-225-1740 with any questions regarding implants.

MRI SCAN OF ABDOMEN OR PELVIS:

Nothing by mouth for 4 hours prior to exam.

Ultrasound

ABDOMINAL/GALL BLADDER: Nothing to eat or drink after midnight or at least 8 hours prior to exam.

PELVIC: 18 or younger/OB > 14 weeks

- 1) Drink 32 oz. of water to be finished 1 hr before appointment.
- 2) Do NOT empty your bladder after drinking the 32 oz. of water. (if you cannot tolerate water, other beverages can be used. AVOID carbonated beverages).

RENAL OR KIDNEY, RENAL DOPPLER:

- 1) Drink 32 oz. (1 quart) of clear fluid to be finished 1 hour before appointment. This is to hydrate your system.
- 2) Do NOT empty your bladder if possible.

VASCULAR STUDIES (Carotid, Femoral, Popliteal, Etc.): No preparation necessary.

THYROID: No preparation necessary.

TRANSVAGINAL: No preparation necessary.
